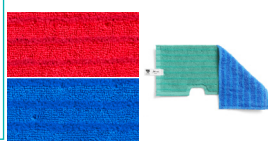

Advantages

- **Colour coded:** the two different coloured sides allow the management of different risk areas with one single mop

- If used with the pre-soaking system, you cut the quantity of necessary mops in half thanks to the two cleaning sides

Washing conditions

Guidelines for proper fibre maintenance

Follow the washing instructions (temperatures and dosage) on the laundry detergent packaging
Perform a pre-wash in cold water without laundry detergent to remove any residual product used during cleaning operations

Recommended use of professional textile laundry detergent

Do not use fabric softener

Do not use laundry detergents with Ph > 11

The use of laundry nets is recommended to speed up and make laundry operations more hygienic

Specific mop instructions



Washing temperature max 90° C, recommended 60°



Bleaching possible, do not use chlorine



Tumble dry or in a dryer possible with low program
